

SHEHRI was formed in 1988 by a group of concerned citizens to provide citizens with a platform to effectively voice their concerns in determining their future and taking action in arresting the deterioration in their living enviornment and proper reform with a view to improve the same.



SHEHRI is based in the city of Karachi and operates as a pressure group and a concious raising organization interfacing with citizens, civic and metropolitan bodies and higher tiers of government. It acts as a catalyst for generating debates and searching for solutions to the urban problems.



SHEHRI - Citizens for a Better Envionment is registered as a non-political organization under the Societies Registration Act. Its membership is open to all who subscribe to its memorandum. It functions in an open, transparent and democratic manner. Elections to the Managing Committee are held every two years. Its accounts are audited by chartered accountants.



We are aware of the steadily worsening environmental conditions in our cities, towns and villages and degradation of our living spaces. We are convinced that it is only through raising public consciousness and effectively articulating public pressure that the process of wanton neglect and corruption can be arrested and an improvement in our environment can be brought about.

The establishment of an Oversee Committee in the Karachi Building Control Authority (KBCA) to monitor the work of KBCA, ensure transparency and suggest improvements.

Shehri has prepared research documents which offer valuable information on various aspects of solid waste management housing system in Karachi.

Shehri has adopted a park in KDA Scheme 3 Block 5, Clifton and is helping the residents to develop the park.

Sherhi has provided a platform for various concerned agencies and organizations to initiate policies and methodologies on issues such as Local Government, urban pollution control, human rights and civil society mobilization

In collaboration with Citizens Police Liaison Committee and Human Rights Commission of Pakistan, Shehri has launched a Gun Free Society campaign in the country. Shehri has prepared a broad based framework of action.
